SYNOPSIS

Captain Vinciguerra leads a platoon of soldiers on a mission in the Balkans to capture a war criminal who has been on the run since the end of the conflict in the ex-Yugoslavia. What Captain Vinciguerra cannot imagine is that he will have to undertake this mission beside his worst enemy: his son, a fierce pacifist. In this situation of adventurous coexistence, among bear eaters and Risk matches, tanks out of control, dreams of revolution and Che Guevara in the middle of a nervous breakdown, father and son will also come to grips with their own very personal conflict.

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

There's a very ill-assorted couple whose relationship revolves around a longstanding and unresolved hostility. Sandro Vinciguerra is an authoritarian army officer while Giacomo, his son, is a mixed up radical pacifist. When Giacomo turns up at the military camp (located in Grz, an imaginary location in the Balkans) where his father is engaged in a peace mission, he is like a malicious virus that wreaks havoc in the area. He destroys all that his father sets up, hinders his career perspectives and undermines his authority. Giacomo is truly mixed up: his arguments are a jumble of different ideologies and his moral guide is a very confused Che Guevara who is definitely experiencing a nervous breakdown. But then, out of Giacomo's chaotic behaviour comes the solution to his father's mission.

The character of the war criminal is based on those criminals still at large many years after the end of the conflict in the ex-Yugoslavian federation. We have imagined him as being weary, forced to live in the wild and to keep running without any hope of escape, all too ready to negotiate his surrender with anyone who has the common sense to talk to him.

The characters have no purpose or direction, they are all empty minded people who need an outside authority to guide them. Their trouble is understanding the meaning of what they do, because they've lost all hold on their feelings and no longer know where to find them.

Giacomo ends up meeting a group of people with whom he can unexpectedly complete his mission. The worlds of son and father end up contaminating each other and, even though for just a fleeting moment, something entirely novel is revealed to them.

FRANCESCO LAGI director & screenplay

Francesco Lagi graduated in film directing from the Centro Sperimentale di Cinematografia. He has directed a few short films (including *Passatempo*), a few videoclips (for Tiromancino, Mannarino, Bugo) and also works for the theatre (*The Golden Ass* based on Apuleius and *Apocalypse* based on John). He has written for film and TV. In 2006 he was one of the directors who collaborated in the episodic film 4-4-2 *II gioco più bello del mondo*.

UMBERTO CONTARELLO screenplay

Umberto Contarello was born in Padua.
